Huntington Bank to sponsor ‘Monday Movies by the Marina’ *Three-installment outdoor film series to be shown in Downtown Charlevoix’s East Park*

The Charlevoix Downtown Development Authority (DDA) is pleased to announce a partnership with Huntington Bank which will result in the screening of three feature films in East Park’s Odmark Performance Pavilion on Monday evenings this summer.

“The two outdoor films we showed last summer were wildly successful, so we’re very pleased that Huntington Bank has generously offered to sponsor additional movies this summer,” said DDA executive director Keith Carey. “The three-film ‘Monday Movies by the Marina’ series will be in addition to the return of ‘Venetian Vision’ resulting in a total of four great flicks being shown in the pavilion this summer.”

The films are projected on a 15’ x 25’ screen with sound provided by the pavilion’s state-of-the-art audio system. Attendees are encouraged to bring lawn chairs and/or blankets. Huntington Bank will also offer free popcorn before the start of each movie.

“Film licensing restrictions prohibit us from revealing the movie titles in the newspaper or on radio, but folks can visit DowntownCharlevoix.com or search “Downtown Charlevoix (MI)” on Facebook.com to learn which film is playing next in the ‘Monday Movies by the Marina’ series,” said Carey. “The dates and times of the Monday showings will be June 28 at 9:15 p.m., August 2 at 9:15 p.m. and August 23 at 8:30 p.m.”

The ‘Venetian Vision’ movie will once again be selected by the community through an online poll hosted by the Charlevoix Courier beginning in mid-July.
