History

The concept of an interactive children's water fountain in East Park was brought to the Charlevoix Downtown Development Authority (DDA) in March 2007 by a resident who believed Downtown should offer more family-oriented activities. A combination of DDA funds, City of Charlevoix monies, grant awards and private fundraising dollars made possible the construction of the [Charlevoix Fountain of Youth](#) and it opened on July 23, 2008. The facility features a safety-textured fountain pad and 23 programmable water nozzles, each with two multi-hued LED light fixtures. Features made possible by additional private donations include heated water, programmable lighting and music and a signature center nozzle capable of sending a stream of water as high as 30 feet.

Interactive Mode

In Interactive Mode, the heated [Charlevoix Fountain of Youth](#) is open for play. The 30' high center nozzle is powered down and the stanchions and rope are removed. Please properly supervise children. Use at your own risk.

Out of respect for our marina patrons, the [Charlevoix Fountain of Youth](#) shuts down between the hours of 7:00 pm and 9:00 pm each evening.

Display Mode

The [Charlevoix Fountain of Youth](#) choreographed music and light shows take place on the half hour and is to be enjoyed from behind the stanchions and rope as the high-pressure center nozzle is engaged and the facility is unsupervised.
